

1 GAS REFILLING

- Prior to filling with butane, make sure the gas refill valve is tight.
- Use only high quality butane gas.
- Make sure the Gas adjustment knob (5) is "OFF".
- Shake gas container a few times to warm fuel up.
- Insert the container nozzle vertically down into the gas refill valve.(Fig.1)
- **Use a pumping action when refilling. If any liquid gas sprays out, the torch is full. DO NOT over-fill to avoid blockage.**
- After fuelling, allow a few minutes for gas to stabilize.

2 IGNITION

- Turn the Gas adjustment knob (5) anticlockwise. (Fig.2)
- The gas will hiss out through the nozzle protection.
- Press the Ignitor button (2) to light the flame. (Fig.3)

3 SETTING THE FLAME

- Fuel consumption ca. 60g/h.
- Set the flame length using the Gas adjustment knob (5).
- Then set the flame width by moving the (6) Flame lever. (Fig.4)
- Turn the Gas adjustment knob (5) clockwise as much as possible to put the flame out, make sure the flame is completely out. (Fig.5)

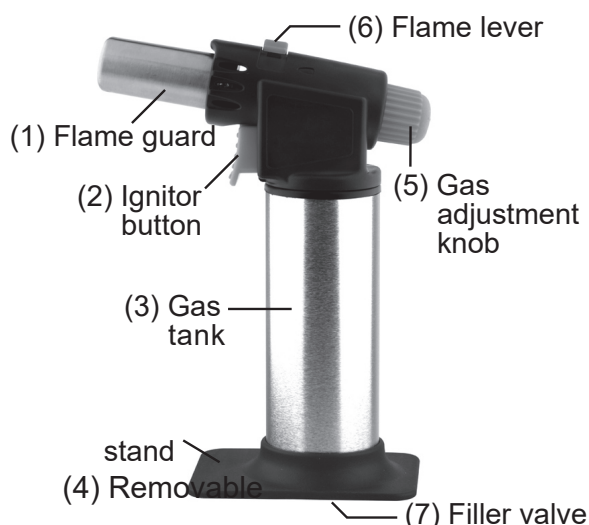
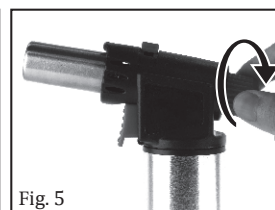
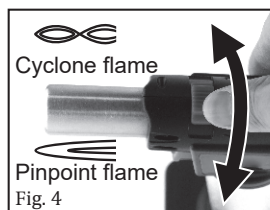
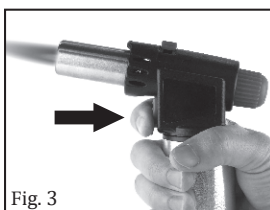
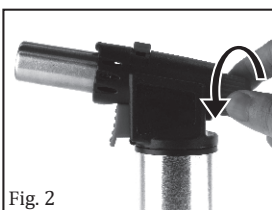
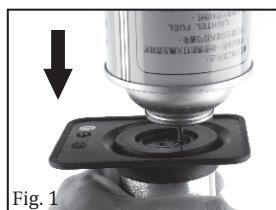
4 DISPOSAL

5 WARNING

1. Carefully read the instructions before using the torch.
Keep the instruction for future use.
2. Operate outside or in a well-ventilated place.
3. Use only Butane lighter fuel.
4. Keep the torch and gas cartridge out of reach of children.
5. Do not use an appliance which shows any damage.

6. Butane is very flammable, handle with care.
7. Refill the tank in a well-ventilated place, in a flame or ignition source free atmosphere, far from other persons.
Do not smoke while replacing or refilling.
8. Before refilling the torch, read the instructions printed on the gas cartridge.
9. Always have a fire extinguisher near the torch and work area.
10. Disassembling, modifying the torch or adding parts may be hazardous.
11. Never attempt to repair the torch and never use unapproved fuels.
12. Do not perforate or burn the gas cartridges even when they are empty.
13. For environmental reasons the gas cartridges should be disposed in specific containers for subsequent recycling.
14. Avoid inhaling fumes. Use a ventilator to maintain good ventilation.
15. Work only in a clean place, far from combustible or greased materials.
16. Do not point the flame toward any person or flammable materials.
17. Allow the torch to cool down normally after use.
Make sure that the torch is shut down before storing.
18. Warning! The flame may not be clearly visible in sunlight.
19. Do not store in temperatures over 40°C (104°F).
Never leave the torch in direct sunlight or in areas where high temperatures are generated.
20. Store the device vertically.
21. Keep the appliance away from grime.
Be careful not to drop the gas torch while using, as it's the most frequent reason for malfunction.
22. **Caution: the flame guard could be very hot after use.**
23. In case of a gas leak (smell of gas), take the appliance outside to a well-ventilated place immediately, where the leak may be checked.
24. Never check the leakage with flame but only with leak detection spray.
25. Do not leave an ignited appliance unattended at any time.



WARNING-CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE!

Do not puncture or incinerate container.

Do Not expose to heat or store at temperatures above 40°C. Keep out of the reach of children.



Operation Advisory:

It is not recommended to point the flame directly downward and operate for more than 10 minutes as the heat may build up and damage the unit.
